# Public transport from Frankfurt Airport to Saarbrücken Main Station

After your arrival please find the long-distance train station at Frankfurt Airport ("Frankfurt am Main Flughafen Fernbahnhof"). The long-distance train station is located opposite **Terminal 1**.

At the train station, there are many connections that you can use to reach Saarbrücken main station ("**Saarbrücken Hauptbahnhof**").

We recommend one of the following tickets:

1. "**Quer-durchs-Land-Ticket**"

1.1. especially when you are traveling in a group as this is the most cost-effective option for you (*1 Person 44€, 2 Persons 51€ in total... 5 persons 72€ in total*). You can buy this ticket at the ticket machines. Please consider that you are just allowed to use this ticket if you are using the **regional trains (RB, IRE, RE)** and **suburban trains (S-Bahn)** but not if you are using the ICE, IC, or EC.

2. "**Deutschlandticket**" (Germany ticket)

1.2. This ticket costs 49€ per month per person. It includes all public transport in Germany (excluding ICE, IC or EC). This "ticket" is a subscription. Therefore, you have to cancel your subscription before the 10. of the previous month; e.g. if you want your ticket just for September you have to cancel the ticket before 10.09. Otherwise, you have to pay another 49€ for October.

Alternatively, you can travel by bus. "**Flixbus**" and "**BlaBlaCar Bus**" companies offer direct connections to Saarbrücken. Please note that if you use these kinds of buses you are not arriving at the Saarbrücken main station but at the "Fernbusbahnhof Saarbrücken" at the Dudweilerstraße. From there you have to use the bus and/or the tram to get to your hotel.

# Public transport from Luxembourg Airport to Saarbrücken Main Station

Public transport in all of Luxembourg is free.

## **Getting to Saarbrücken by bus**

There is a frequent bus shuttle that commutes between Saarbrücken main train station and the train station in Luxembourg ("Luxembourg Gare").

Please take the bus from the airport to the train station in Luxembourg. There is one good bus connection which runs several times per hour.:

Once you have arrived at the train station in Luxembourg ("Luxembourg Gare"), you can take the shuttle bus to Saarbrücken train station: <https://www.emile-weber.lu/fr/ligne-bus-saarbruecken-express.html>

The cost for the ticket is 5€ and the transfer takes about 1hr 15 min.

Tickets are bought directly on the bus or online.

# Public Transport in Saarbrücken

If you buy a "Germany ticket" (Deutschlandticket) for 49€ per month per Person, you can use all public transport (excluding ICE, IC, and RE). This "ticket" is a subscription. Therefore, you have to cancel your subscription before the 10. of the previous month; e.g. if you want your ticket just for September you have to cancel the ticket before 10.09. Otherwise, you have to pay another 49€ for October.

For shorter stays, we recommend a "week ticket" (Wochenkarte for 22,50€. This allows you to use trains and buses in Saarbrücken (and the entire Saarland region) for one week. Make sure your Week ticket is for "zone" (Wabe) 111

For even shorter stays we recommend "day tickets" (Tageskarte) for 5,20€ a day in Saarbrücken or 9,40€ a day for the entire Saarland. Feel free to mix and match these tickets to suit your preferences.

For detailed Travel Itineraries, download the mobile app "**Saarfahrplan**". Here you can enter your starting point and where you want to go. The app shows you all alternatives (which bus stop, which bus number, and so on):

Travel between "**Main station**" (Hauptbahnhof) and the **University**:

- Bus 124 leaves every 15-30 minutes and takes 15 minutes to arrive at the university/main station.

If you want to travel between the "**Main station**" (Hauptbahnhof) and the **city centre**:









- You can walk as the main station is really central
- You can use each tram on **track S** to the tram stop "**Johanneskirche**" (there's the city hall)
- Every 3-10 minutes there is a tram

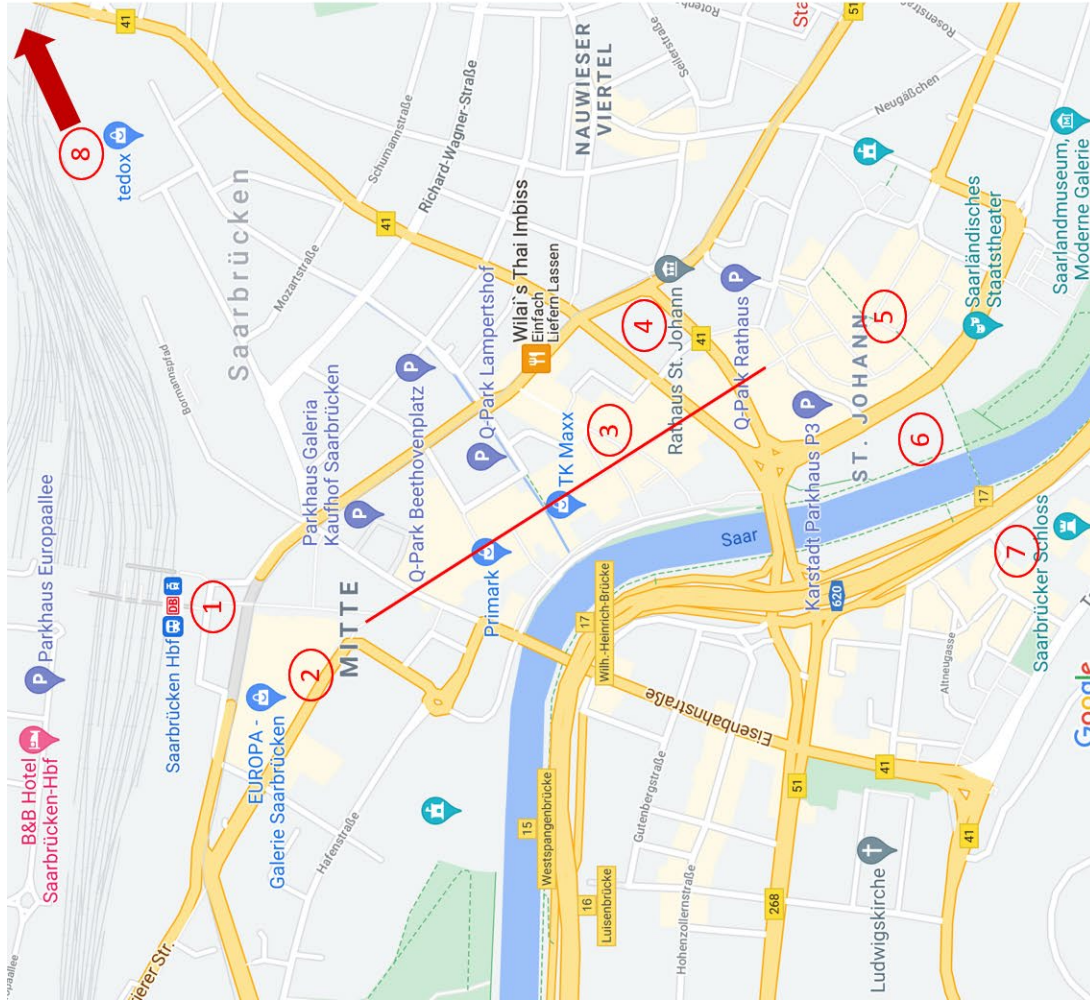
If you want to travel from the **University** to the **City centre**:

- You can use the following buses to Johannes Kirche or Rabbiner-Rülf-Platz: 101, 102, 109, 124

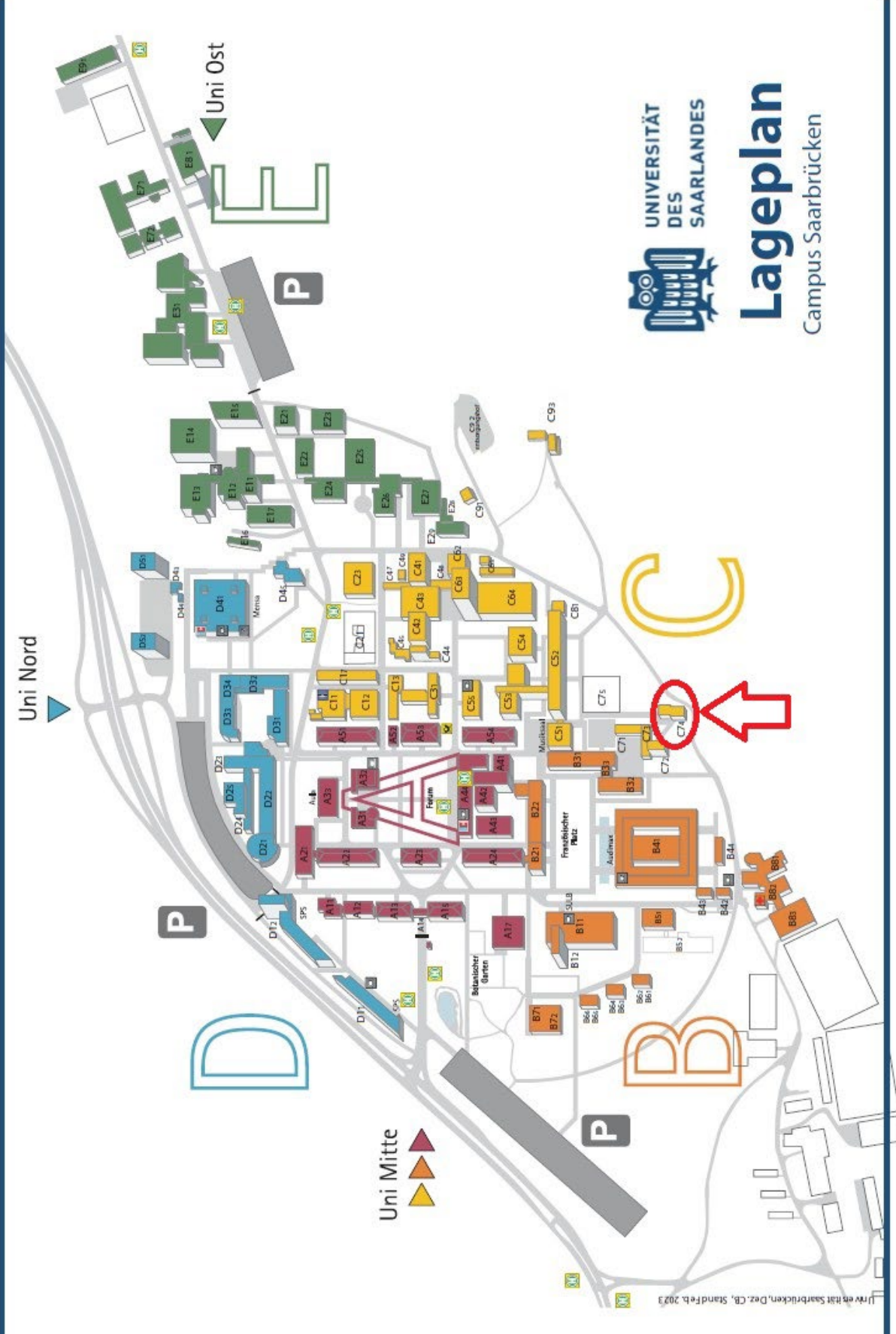
If you want to travel from the **City centre** to the **University**:

- You can use the following busses from town hall (Rathaus): 102, 109, 101,102, 150
