

**Information sheet**  
for Master theses assessments (7<sup>th</sup> of February 2019)

Dear assessor,

A master thesis should be assessed within 3 months after submission. This deadline is set by the examination catalogue and is binding.

The first and second assessor, submit a written assessment of the master thesis before the deadline with the corresponding grade. The assessor can assign the following grades:

The master thesis is regarded as passed when the first and second assessor mark it as at least sufficient. In this case the student received 30 credit point (Master Sports in Health)/20 credit points (Master High-Performance Sport).

**PLEASE NOTE:** in case the grades assigned by the first and second assessor differ, the average of these two grades will be the final grade for the master thesis.

When the grades assigned by the first and second assessor differ more than 1.0, or if one assessor grades the master thesis as a fail, a third assessor is invite. In this case the final grade is based on the grade assigned by all three assessors.

In case of failing the master thesis, it can be repeated once.
