

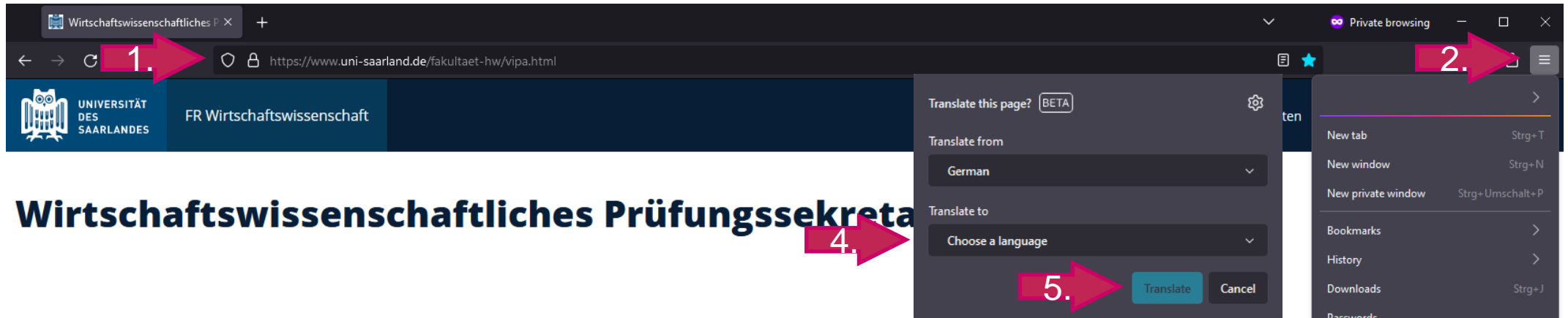

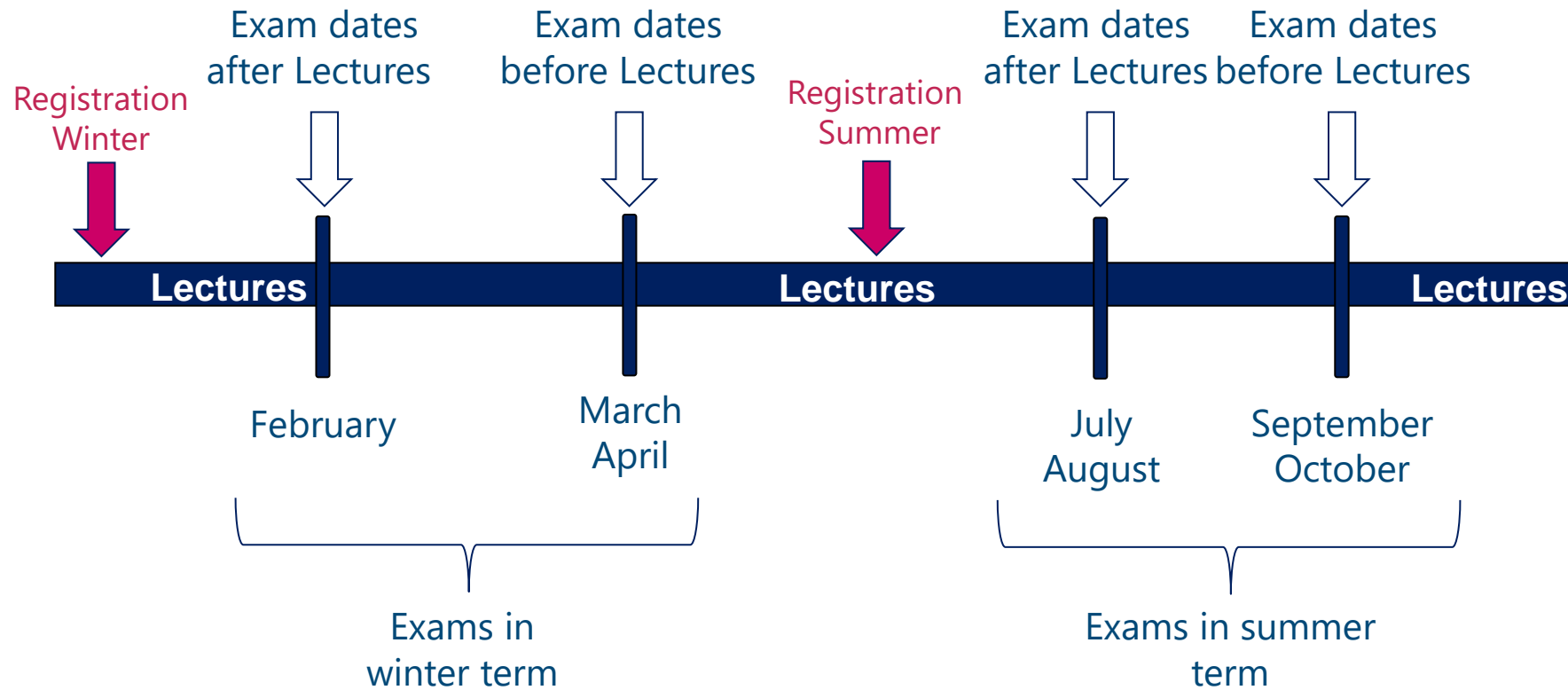

- There is **only one** registration period per semester.
- Exams for lectures read in the respective semester take place in the 1st period, after the lectures.
- Exams for lectures that were **not** read in the respective semester take place in the 2nd period, before the lectures of the next semester
- Only one examination can be taken per course and semester.

General information about the economic sciences exams

- Each module exam (exam except final theses) can be taken a **maximum of three** times
- Failure to pass the same exam three times - regardless of compulsory or elective subject!

→ **Loss of examination entitlement! = FORCED EXMATRICULATION**

- Passed exams **cannot** be repeated
- All achievements can only be submitted **once**
- **Illness during exams:** Regulations see PO§10 and homepage
- **Attempted cheating:** Exam will be graded 5.0 (failed attempt!)

Loss of the right to examinations

- **Consequence:** If you lose your right to take examinations, you will generally no longer be able to German university to study your chosen degree program.
- **Reasons for loss of examination entitlement:**
 - Failed a module exam (except final theses) for the 3rd time
 - Failed the Bachelor's or Master's thesis for the 2nd time
 - Plagiarism

Please contact us at an early stage if you are in danger of losing your examination not only when it is already too late!


