## Scope and Completion of the Minor Subject

The minor subject in Business Administration is considered successfully completed by the major subject department once the following requirements have been fulfilled:

Major: **Mathematics** (Bachelor's Degree) with Minor in Business Administration (36 CP in total)

- 4 modules from the field of Business Administration (24 CP)
- 2 modules from the field of Economics (12 CP)

Major: **Computer Science** (Bachelor's Degree) with Minor in Business Administration (18 CP in total)

- 3 modules from the field of Business Administration and/or Economics (18 CP)

In addition, the certificate of academic achievement issued by the Examinations Office of Business and Economics must be submitted to the responsible examinations office of the major subject.

## Examination Registration

Registration for examinations is carried out exclusively online via the FN2 registration portal (not via the LSF portal).

The regular registration and withdrawal deadlines of Examinations Office of Business and Economics apply and must be strictly observed.

Without proper and timely registration, participation in examinations is not possible.

## FN2 Account

Upon enrollment in the major subject, an FN2 account for a possible minor in Economics and Business Administration is automatically created.

Therefore, no additional registration of the minor subject is required.

## Important Information

1. A failed examination may be repeated a maximum **of two times**.
2. **Failing an examination for the third time** results in the **permanent loss of examination eligibility** in the minor subject Economics and Business Administration.
3. After successful completion of the minor subject, no further examinations in Economics and Business Administration may be taken due to admission restrictions.
4. Examinations that have already been passed may not be repeated.
5. As a rule, each examination is offered **once** per semester.
6. The loss of examination eligibility in the minor subject Economics and Business Administration generally also excludes students from pursuing a degree in Economics and Business Administration at a German university at a later date.
