

German language courses for international students

Summer semester 2024

Duration of courses: 29 April to 26 July 2024

General language courses (twice a week, 6 ECTS credits per course)

- → **German language course for beginners** (who have never studied German before)

 2x 3 academic hours per week (usually 6 8.15 p.m.)

 For UdS students (incl. students in exchange programmes), doctoral students and postdocs of the UdS free of charge, for all other participants*: 180 Euro / Semester
- → German language courses from CEFR level A1.2 to C1

2x 2 academic hours per week (usually from 18 o'clock)
For UdS students (incl. students in exchange programmes), doctoral students and postdocs of the UdS free of charge, for all other participants*: 120 Euros / Semester

Special skills courses (once a week, 3 ECTS credits per course)

- → **German grammar** (level A2/B1 and above, 3 level)
- → Conversation course (level A2/B1 and above, 2 level)
- → **Phonetics** (level B1 and above, one course)
- → **German cultural studies** (level B1 and above, one course)
- → **German for business and economics** (level B1 and above, one course)
- → **German for technical purposes** (level B2 and above, one course)
- → **German for academic purposes: Writing and presenting** (level B1 and above, one course)
- → Conversation course for doctoral students (level A2/B1 and above, 2 level)

each course 1x 2 academic hours per week in the afternoon or evening
For UdS students (incl. students in exchange programmes), doctoral students and postdocs
of the UdS free of charge, for all other participants*: 60 Euros each course / Semester
