Costs of Living (estimated)	Semester fee: tbd (including public transport) Accommodation: from 350 EUR/month Food: 180 EUR/month Plus private expenses Living expenses average between 750 - 950 EUR per month (BA/MA students). The actual costs may vary. The proof of finance demanded by the visa office is 11.208 EUR/year (934/month) for student visa holders.
Semester Fee	There are no tuition fees applicable at the Saarland University. However, it is mandatory for students to pay a small fee corresponding to: - The administrative cost related to the establishment of the Student ID card - The semester ticket which allows for public transportation in the federal state of Saarland. The fee for exchange students tbd per semester. Health Insurance	A valid health insurance is mandatory for the enrolment: European Health Insurance Card delivered to all EU citizens. All incoming Erasmus students will be provided with detailed information about the health insurance (EU and Non-EU citizens).
