Requirements for studies at Saarland University

- Continuous enrollment at home university
- At least one year of studies at home university before starting the mobility
- Bilateral Agreement between home university and Saarland University
- Language skills

Mandatory application papers (scanned copies by email to Mr. Heintz, no hardcopies required)

- official letter of nomination by the Erasmus+ coordinator at your home university
- application form for admission (*Zulassungsantrag*)
- CV in English
- color copy of your passport (identification page with your personal data and photo)
- *for students:* letter of purpose with preliminary list of courses at Saarland University
official transcript of records
- *for research internships / PhD candidates:* invitation letter from your supervisor at Saarland University

Documents after your acceptance (will be sent by Mr. Heintz)

- Learning agreement (to sign by your home coordinator)
- Grant agreement
- Confirmation of arrival (to sign by the coordinator at Saarland University)

Application deadlines

summer semester: December 1st
winter semester: June 1st
