- for *research* internships / *PhD candidates*: copy of the invitation letter issued by your supervisor at Saarland University

- Learning agreement (to sign by your home coordinator)
- Confirmation of arrival (to sign by the coordinator at Saarland University)
- Grant agreement (hardcopy)
