Saarland University has established its own seed funding scheme that enables researchers to apply for funding for research activities involving at least one of the T4EU partner universities. The aim is to encourage research within the T4EU alliance and to foster networking. Projects in the scheme are often smaller-scale projects designed to encourage collaborative research interaction between partners, such conferences, articles for academic journals or networking events. To give you an idea of the range of projects being undertaken, some of the researchers who successfully applied for seed funding will present their results and talk about their experiences.
