Semester fee



The semester fee for exchange students is 210,10 EUR for summer term 2026 (winter term 2025: 210,10 EUR)

The exchange program is written **on your admission letter** and you can pay accordingly.

The semester fee for **freemover** students is 394,30 EUR for summer term 2026 (winter term 2025: 394,30 EUR)

- Starting winter term 2024/25 the semester ticket will <u>include</u> the "Deutschlandticket"



"Saved"

Only you can see the application and you can still make changes.

"Submitted"

You application can now be reviewed and processed by the admission's office. You can no longer make changes.

"Valid" or "Approved"

As soon as the Admissions Office has checked your enrolment request, and if everything was complete, the application will change to "valid" or "approved". At this point, the enrolment system is only waiting for the semester fee to be received. Once the semester fee has been received, your enrolment is complete and you will be able to download your university credentials ("Kennungsschreiben").

Download your personal UdS ID - Kennungsschreiben





- 1. Log into SIM application portal
- 2. Open your enrolment file
- 3. Go to "Documents"
- 4. Scroll down to "My certifications"
- 5. Download the "Kennungsschreiben"
- 6. Change the password!

Sometimes it can take up to 48 h until you are able to change the password!

After the enrolment is valid



If you have given an address in **Germany, France, Luxembourg or Switzerland** during the online enrolment, the card will be sent to this address!

If you have given an address in **any other** country, you need to pick up the card in the Student Service Center (SSC). You receive an email. The card will be ready after ~3 work days!
