transparency of your research. The APA's data sharing policy does not
require public posting, so you are free to decide what is best for your
project in terms of public data, materials, and conditions on their use.

Note, however, that APA policy does require that authors make their data available to other researchers upon request. Therefore, making your data openly available now, while the project is fresh in your mind, will save you time in the long run. As part of APA's ongoing efforts to increase transparency and collaboration in scientific research, our journal now offers authors the option of depositing their data into APA's own repository hosted by the Center for Open Science at <https://osf.io/view/apa/>. The repository will store and archive research data, protocols and materials, with data being made open once it is published in an APA journal. If you choose to submit your data to the repository, please include the dataset's OSF link as part of your author note, and include the data citation in your reference list.
