In accordance with § 7 Abs. 1 S. 1 of the Election Regulations of the Student Body of Saarland University (WO-StuPa), I hereby announce the elections for the 68th Student Parliament of Saarland University.

Date and location of the presence election

The elections for the 68th Student Parliament will take place from 4 - 7 July 2022.

Eligibility to vote and exercise of the right to vote

All students who are enrolled at Saarland University in the summer semester (deadline 1 April 2022) are eligible to vote. The right to vote consists of an **active** and a **passive** right to vote. Students who are entitled to vote thus have the right to vote actively and to be elected passively.

In order to exercise the **right to vote,** voting must take place either at the polling locations during voting times or by post in accordance with the requirements of the election regulations. To vote at the polling stations during voting hours, a valid student ID card of Saarland University or an official identification document (identity card or passport) must be presented.

The **right to stand for election is** exercised through candidacy. To stand as a candidate on a list or as a direct candidate, a written application must be submitted to the election officer for the elections to the 68th Student Parliament of Saarland University. On the website for this year's StuPa elections (https://www.uni-saarland.de/page/stupa-wahl.html) you will find the relevant forms for downloading, which contain all further information.

I hereby call upon you to submit election proposals in accordance with § 7 Abs. 2 S. 2 WO-StuPa! Nominations for the elections to the 68th Student Parliament can be submitted until **10 June 2022** (submission deadline).

Elections to the 68th Student Parliament

Postal voting

Pursuant to § 30 Abs. 1 WO-StuPa, a postal vote is possible if the person entitled to vote cannot exercise his/her right to vote or can only do so with unreasonable difficulty due to illness or physical infirmity, holiday, stay abroad or other absence during the election for good cause.

An application for a **postal** vote in these cases is possible from now **until 30 June 2022.**

List of persons entitled to vote

The persons entitled to vote have been entered in the registers of eligible voters (electoral roll) as of the cutoff date (1 April 2022). The electoral roll is compiled from the official and current student statistics of the General Student Secretariat.

Every person entitled to vote has the right to inspect the electoral roll until **10 June 2022.** Anyone who considers the electoral roll to be incorrect or inaccurate may raise objections to the electoral roll with the election officer within this period.

The request to inspect the electoral roll must be sent by e-mail to the election officer (v.heintz@mx.uni-saar-land.de). The request must include the surname, first names, date of birth and matriculation number of the person entitled to vote and the person making the request.
