

No Military Research at University!

A civil clause must be introduced – committing the university to conduct research only for civilian purposes. We also demand a ban on advertisement for the Bundeswehr.

More Offers & More Funding for Mental Health!

The psychological counseling service is overwhelmed – we demand more funding, staff, and accessible support options.

Expand Bike Infrastructure!

We call for safe, well-maintained bike paths and bike stands on campus, on access routes, and throughout Saarbrücken and Homburg.

Fair Discounts for All Students

Students over 27 are often excluded from discounts – we demand age-independent benefits and a student ID that clearly indicates full-time student status.

A Multilingual Campus!

Free language courses, evening programs, and support for trilingualism are essential. Job postings must also be available in English.

Support for International Students!

Abolish blocked accounts, recognize language courses with credit points – for real equity and inclusion.

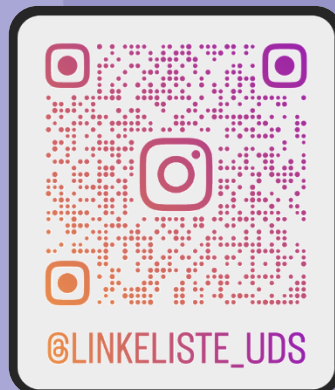
For a Political Student Body That Gets Involved!

Left Perspectives for Saarland University:

The Left List is an informal group of students who want to engage in leftist politics. What unites us is our discomfort with the current conditions at Saarland University. We refuse to accept them as they are. Together, we have developed a set of points to outline a leftist vision for our campus.:

Affordable Coffee for All!

We demand more affordable cafés on campus that not only provide low-cost food and drinks but also serve as spaces for student exchange – following the model of the Philo-Café.

More Student Spaces on Campus

There's a shortage of study spaces – we need more quiet areas in and outside the libraries. We also call for self-managed common rooms where students can relax without having to spend money.

Better Working Conditions for Student Assistants!

A €16 minimum wage for all university employees – from student assistants to cleaning staff. We demand fair contracts, job security, and an empowered staff council. We support the TVStud movement and call for a binding collective agreement for student workers.

Study How You Want!

Mandatory attendance and progress checks must go. All lectures must be offered in hybrid format – both online and in person. This ensures flexibility for jobs, illness, or caregiving responsibilities.

Consistently Against Tuition Fees!

The so-called administrative fee is a hidden tuition fee – we demand its abolition. The state should cover rising student service costs, not the students.

Reduce and Maintain the Germany Ticket!

We support keeping the discounted Germany Ticket in a solidarity-based model for all students.

Decisive Push for Comprehensive BAföG Reform!

We call for BAföG to be a full grant, independent of age, parents, and academic performance – with increased allowances, housing subsidies, and simplified procedures. Standard periods of study must be extended.

Expand Mensa Services!

We want to keep the evening service. A subsidized vegan meal must be available at all times. Renovation and preservation of the Mensa are non-negotiable.

Expand Culture and Leisure Flat Rates!

Free access for students to theaters, cinemas, museums, and pools across Saarland. Uni parties and the Uni-Film program must remain, but student-run. We also demand improved night bus service linking the city center, campus, and Dudweiler.

Active Against the Far Right, Racism, and Antisemitism!

A new AStA department should offer information and support on anti-fascism and anti-racism. Feminist and queer initiatives as well as critical orientation weeks must be strengthened.

Against the Culture War from the Right!

We advocate for gender-inclusive language, simplified name changes, and public awareness about far-right networks in Saarland and beyond.

Firm Stance Against Neoliberalism and Conservatism!

No coalitions with RCDS, LHG, or conservative groups – we stand for a leftist, solidarity-based student representation.

Improve Student Housing!

More dormitories – affordable and publicly managed – not luxury housing like in Meerwiesertal. We demand a rent cap for student housing and a housing office to assist with finding accommodation and financial issues. We also call for campaigns promoting social housing.

Our Demands for the Homburg Campus

Better bike paths, more learning and lounge spaces with sofas, improved shuttle services, and equal access to cultural events regardless of age. The campus festival must be accessible to medical students and not scheduled during the "MediMeisterschaften" weekend.

Unbureaucratic Aid for Students in Poverty!

We demand a permanent emergency relief fund for students in financial crisis.

No Honors for Nazis!

Honorary titles for former Nazis like Röchling, Mühlenberg, and Simonis must be revoked immediately.

Consistent Climate Policy – Ecological AND Social!

We call for a car-free campus, better public transportation, energy-efficient renovations, and a new parking concept that reduces traffic. More trash bins and ashtrays are also needed.
