Room-specific guidelines for use as a Family Room

Use of the room is subject to the terms of use for Family Rooms at Saarland University, which are displayed in the room. By booking the room or accepting the room key/key card, authorised users and carers are deemed to have fully accepted the terms of use, either at the time of booking or upon entering the Family Room.

Location

Building E1 2, room 0.09

Authorised users

After registering at the Disability Support Service, all UdS students and employees have access and can book flexibly.

Equipment

The Diversity Room is a multifunctional space that can be used for a variety of purposes. For example, pregnant women and breastfeeding mothers will find a reclining breastfeeding chair and a yoga mat. The room is also equipped with a KidsBox for childcare.

The Diversity Room can be used as a workplace for people who are blind or have a visual impairment, and it offers technical support for those with dyslexia. It can also be used as an additional exam room, a study room, or a quiet room for people on the autism spectrum, people with ADHD, pregnant women, and older people. The room can also be used as a prayer and meditation space.
