

Parent-Child-Room at the SULB

Room-specific guidelines for use as a Family Room

Use of the room is subject to the terms of use for Family Rooms at Saarland University, which are displayed in the room. By booking the room or accepting the room key/key card, authorised users and carers are deemed to have fully accepted the terms of use, either at the time of booking or upon entering the Family Room.

Location

Building B1 1, first floor, behind the German Studies information desk. Barrier-free access is available via the lift.

Authorised users

The room is unlocked and available for use by all library visitors. Visitors with children have priority.

Equipment

Parents and children can work and study here while the children play in the play area. Adults can use the PC workstation, while children can sit at the small table with a chair and a beanbag, or play with the children's books and toys. The room cannot be seen from the corridor.

If required, an additional breastfeeding facility is available in the nursing room on the first floor of the café area, in case the parent-child room is too 'public' for the breastfeeding mother. This room is locked. The key can be obtained from the information desk in the entrance area.

Access

Reservations can be made via the SULB booking system. People who have registered to use the library can make these reservations.
