Room-specific guidelines for use as a Family Room

Use of the room is subject to the terms of use for Family Rooms at Saarland University, which are displayed in the room. By booking the room or accepting the room key/key card, authorised users and carers are deemed to have fully accepted the terms of use, either at the time of booking or upon entering the Family Room.

Location

Building E1 1, room U16

Authorised users

Members of the Collaborative Research Centre/Transregio 248 'Fundamentals of Comprehensible Software Systems' are entitled to use it. Access is open to all students and employees of the UoS after registration via the SFB office or the Family Office.

Equipment

The room is located on the ground floor and is fully accessible. It is equipped with a wide range of diversity-sensitive toys and games for children of all ages. As well as popular classics such as books, puzzles and colouring materials, there are also more unusual items, including giant puzzles, tactile memory games and sensory jars. Other activities include inclusive play figures, various construction materials, board games and stacking blocks. There is also a height-adjustable desk, which makes it possible to combine childcare with work or study. Lockers are available for storing personal belongings safely.
