




The Contact Point for Studying with Disability (Kontaktstelle Studium und Behinderung- KSB) at Saarland University works with all students with disability and chronic diseases, who require reasonable accommodations. Diverse aspects play a role: accessibility of buildings and rooms, barrier-free communication, technical aids, the support of teachers, the compensation of disadvantages in all areas of study (for example, during exams), service offers and much more. We know that if reasonable accommodations are not adequately provided, it can lead to difficulties with studies and dropout. We believe this should not be the case. Hence, we provide the information and support for students to succeed at Saarland University. We encourage you to contact the office of KSB for further information.

## Studying with Disability and Chronic Diseases

The term 'disability' often reminds us of the physical impairments, the ones that are visible to others. However, individuals do have impairments that are invisible to others, such as diabetes, depression, dyslexia, and autism to name a few. In addition, there are diseases and conditions that are chronic in nature that could limit one's social functioning. Conditions where social participation is restricted could be rheumatism, multiple sclerosis, Crohn's disease, mental health impairments, obesity, cancer and more.

Providing reasonable accommodations should compensate the disadvantages caused by such conditions. The Contact Point for Studying with Disability helps with your applications for compensation to your *Study Committee*. We are happy to provide advice, information and if necessary appropriate recommendations.
