The Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science invites applications for the following position (m/f/x), which should be filled as soon as possible:

Full Professor (W3) for Computer Science (Ref. No. W1505)

Active contribution to research and teaching, including basic lectures in computer science, is expected.

Teaching languages are English or German (basic courses). We expect sufficient German language skills after an appropriate period.

Saarland University seeks applications from outstanding individuals who have a proven international record of excellent research following an outstanding PhD degree.

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Saarland University combines excellent student training with excellence in research and development. It is regularly found among the best departments esp. in computer science rankings. The Department of Computer Science collaborates closely with a number of internationally renowned state-of-the-art research institutes in informatics: the Max Planck Institute for Informatics, the Max Planck Institute for Software Systems, the CISPA - Helmholtz Center for IT Security, the German Research Center for Artificial Intelligence, the Saarbrücken Graduate School of Computer Science, the research unit Multimodal Computing and Interaction, and the Center for Bioinformatics. All of these institutes are within short distance of each other on campus.

At Saarland University internationalization is a cross-cutting task. We therefore expect the participation in activities for the further internationalization of the university. In addition, the “University of the Greater Region” network supports cooperation with institutes in the cross-border region SaarLorLux (www.uni-gr.eu).

We are looking for scientifically excellent applicants who also demonstrate very good teaching skills. The willingness and ability to seek third-party-funding, independently as well as in co-operation, is also expected.

Besides the requirements stipulated by public sector employment law, the necessary qualifications for hiring include tertiary education, pedagogical suitability, particular ability for scientific work, which is generally shown with an outstanding doctoral degree, as well as additional scientific achievements, e.g. a habilitation or research and teaching experience as assistant professor.
